The original corner and accessories have been destroyed by road construction and extensive farming.

R.S. Scott Corner and accessories have also been destroyed by road reconstruction. I found a P.K. nail in centerline of Simar-Wasas Road on the extension of a fenceline to the East. This position re-established by unknown surveyor works reasonably

Distances from this position to existing stream crossing work reasonably well with GLO distances.

I accepted the position of the existing P.K. nail as the corner position and have monumented it as such.
