

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No original evidence was found. At the apparent corner position I found a 4" squared cedar post standing. This was in conformance with the calculated position. A forester had run a blue paint line North from this post for the purpose of logging West in Section 7. There was a yellow bearing tree sign, almost completely rusted away on a tree 25 feet Northwest of the cedar post. There were two blazed cedar trees facing post. I accepted the cedar post as the only logical position for the corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position I set a 3/4"X48" aluminum rod with a 3" cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation, T50N R42W, S7, S8, S17, S18, 1999, P.S. 17610. I established three bearing trees and a reference object.
