I found no remains of the original comer or accessories. I re-established the corner at a proportionate distance between the Southwest Corner of Section 36, T51N, R38W and the South ½ Corner of Section 31, T51N, R37W. I held the middle of an old mining road bed for the North-South position. The corner now falls in a beaver marsh in middle of submerged road bed.
