

1, Joseph C. A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(B-13) South ¼ Corner of Section 31, T51N, R37W Corner is on 5th Correction Line.

1939 - Copper Range Corner Records: A 1 ½" I.P. 3 feet above ground was found at the corner which worked well with original B.T. (14" Cedar - down). He placed a location poster on a 9" Basswood S 40° W 18 feet.

1980 - Keith Sackett, P.S. 19006, for Michigan DNR, found a 1 1/2" iron pipe 3' high and a location poster on a dead stub S 41° W 18 feet. The corner is recorded at Ontonagon County Register of Deeds, Liber 1, Page 202 of Corner Records. He established 3 scribed N.B.T.s:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner

I found the iron pipe as called for by Sackett and Copper Range Records. I found the fallen remains of the Cedar B.T. as called for by copper Range. It also recovered the remains of Sackett's N.B.T.s. The 7" Maple to the NE is now fallen. I accepted the iron pipe as the 1/4 corner and drove it down, placing an aluminum rod and cap in it. I established 3 new bearing trees and placed a nail in the side of the remaining DNR N.B.T.s. The DNR distances were to the notch in the face of the trees.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a %" x 48" aluminum rod driven into a 2" O.D. iron pipe, with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; S. 31; ½; S.C.; T.51N, R.37W; 1998; P.S. 37273. Corner falls in a Cedar.swamp.
