

At 8.00 chains (528') to West, he intersected a ridge of trapose rock, course N-S. Copper Range Comer Records: A 1" iron pin was found 6" above ground.

They marked a 6" Basswood N 11° E 28 feet and a 6" Elm N 51° W 23 feet.

Old Mining Map, on file with Steve Hein, P.S. 32336, shows this corner and distances to corners East and Undated -

Keith Sackett, P.S. 19006, for Michigan DNR, found 1" steel pin. The corner is recorded at Ontonagon 1976 -

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of original corner or accessroles. I found a 1" iron pin as called for by Copper Range and Sackett. I found an Elm stump N51° W 23' as per Copper Range. I recovered remains of Sackett's N.B.T.s. The Yellow Birch is down and rotten. The 8" Sugar is dead but still standing. Distance East to the ridge call works well (520' measured). Distances to corners East and West on the Correction Line work well with Old Mining Map distances:

SE Corner Section 32 N 89° 42' 46" E I accepted the iron pin as the Standard Section Corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap placed over the 1" iron pin. The cap is stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; S. 32, S. 31; S.C.; T.51N, R.37W; 1998; P.S. 37273. Corner falls Witnesses: OF BIENT
