

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original comer or accessories. At the corner position I found a 1 ½" x 24" iron pipe and an aluminum location poster on a down Balsam. I also found an old squared cedar post lying flat next to the pipe. The position of the pipe works very well with other corners recovered along the 5th correction line to the East and West. I accepted it as the ½ corner and replaced it with a County Monument.
