COUNTE PARTICIPE -22-98 1955 - Michigan State Highway Department, M.S.H.D., in M-35 Highway Plans Project 66-15, show a 1" iron pipe at this corner, 57,28 feet South of centerline of M-38.

1967 - Donald D. Lappala, R.L.S. 12585, recorded this corner in Liber 1, Page 17 of Corner Records and in Forest Service Liber at the Ontonagon County Register of Deeds Office. He restored the corner by single proportionate measurement between the Standard ¼ Corner of Section 35 and the Standard Meander Corner of Section 36. He set a 2" I.D. x 5' concrete filled galvanized iron pipe, capped with a 3" bronze cap. He

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. I recovered the monument and accessories as recorded by Lappala. A Department of Conservation aluminum tag, dated 1962, facing away from Lappala's comer, indicates a pipe for the corner. I found no remains of this pipe called for by M.S.H.D. Lappala does not mention it. I have determined from the Highway Plans that the pipe fell 20.7' North of Leppala's corner. After evaluating both positions I have determined that the M.S.H.D. pipe would be too far North of the 5th Correction line, as evidenced by the accepted corners to the East and West. I have therefore accepted Lappala's corner as the correct Section Corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 2" x 5' long concrete filled galvanized iron pipe with a 3" diameter bronze cap stamped to read: S.C.; S.35,

S.36; T.51N, R.37W; 1967; R.L.S. 12585. The corner falls 78 feet South of the centerline of M-38.
