B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. I found a fence to the South, a powerline to the North and South, and a fenceline to the West. This position falls in a small creek bed. Longtime resident to the South, John Myllylahti, told me that the Corner used to be a pipe in the creek. I recovered a bent, buried 2" iron pipe in the creek at the mouth of a culvert. This pipe falls very close to a single prorated position. The pipe falls 4 feet East of the powerline and 4 feet South of the fence to the West. I accepted the bent pipe as the 1/4 Corner and replaced it with an iron pin in a pile of rocks.
