1976 - Keith Sackett, P.S. 19006, for Michigan DNR, found a 1" I.D. Iron pipe and also a hemlock log with scribing— 14" Y. Birch 12" Sugar N 10° W 28.8' possible original bearing tree. He established three N.B.T.s:

S 25° E 21.8'

S 22° W 13.0'

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

At the corner I found the pipe as called for by Sackett and the rotted remains of a fallen 14-16" Hemlock at the position of the original Hemlock B.T. I found all three of Sackett's N.B.T.s. His 22" Sugar N.B.T. falls at the position of Austin Burt's original B.T. and could very possibly be the same tree. The distance South to the Southeast Corner and distance North to the Northeast Corner work well with GLO.

I accepted the pipe as the corner and have monumented it as such.
