

I found no remains of the original comer or accessories. The old River Road which traveled along the left bank of the Ontonagon River would have destroyed the Corner and Bearing Trees. I re-established the corner position by single proportionate Measurement between Section Corners east and west.

The Corner is a 2 ½" x 30" diameter aluminum monument with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: County Remonumentation; T51N, R39W; ¼; S. 18, S. 19; 1999; P.S. 37273. The corner falls 5' South and 18' West of the top of bank of the Ontonagon River.
