

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(C-6) 1/2 Corner Common to Sections 17 & 18, T51N, R39W

No Date Mead Woodlands comer notes indicate a 4" balsam post at the corner with a yellow tag on a 3" Red Maple, N 66°E, 7'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original ¼ corner or accessories. I found the Balsam Post and the yellow tag called for by Mead. The yellow tag was a Forest Service location poster with "Appx. 1/2 cor. 21 Apr. 71" written on it. The Balsam post is now fallen. The post falls 3.7' East and 13.0' South of a single prorated position. The yellow tag falls 1.3' West and 9.8' South of a single prorated position. I did not accept either the post or the tag. I believe the single proportionate position best represents the original GLO ¼ corner position and have placed a monument at that position.
