

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. Earl Applekamp's 5/8" pin has been obliterated by Woodspur Road reconstruction. I works well with occupation and with Section Corners North and South. I accepted and monumented this position, recreated the position of his pin using recovered Right-of-Way corners and distances shown on his survey. This position

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the comer:

Corner is a 5/8" iron pin with a 3" diameter brass cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T.51N, R.39W; 1/4; S.4, S.5; 1999; P.S. 37273. Corner falls 2' east of centerline of Woodspur Road. I also established a Reference Monument (R.M.) to the east; a 2 ½" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the ½ corner is N86°18'W 25.47'. Ties:
