A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. At the ½ corner position I found a North – South Paved road (Woodspur Road) running along the section line. I found no other evidence of the corner position. I reestablished the ½ corner position midway between Section Corners to the North and South and on centerline of Woodspur Road. This position works well with GLO distances North and South.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" iron pin with a 3" diameter brass cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T.51N, R.39W; ½; S.8, S.9; 1999; P.S. 37273. Corner falls on centerline of Woodspur Road. I also established a Reference Monument (R.M.) to the east; a ¾ " x 48" aluminum rod with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the ¼ corner is N88°20'W 31.16'.
