B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. At the 1/2 corner position I found a North - South Paved road (Woodspur Road) running along the Section line and a fenceline running East along the ½ line. I created a position for the ½ comer at the intersection of centerline of the North - South road and the extension of the fence to the east. This position is 2644.32 feet north of the Southeast corner of Section 17 and is the best remaining evidence of the 1/2 corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" fron pin with a 3" diameter brass cap stamped to read: COUNTY REMONUMENTATION; T.51N, R.39W; 1/4; S.17, S.16; 1999; P.S. 37273. Corner falls at the intersection of centerline of Woodspur Road and the extension of a fenceline to the East. I also established a Reference Monument (R.M.) to the east; a ¾ " x 48" aluminum rod with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to indicate that the ¼ corner is S88°57'W 33.43'. Ties:
