

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E-7) Corner Common to Sections 16, 17, 20 and 21, T51N, R39W.

1949 - U.S. Highway 45 construction plans show 3/1 iron pin at this corner and distances to Section Corners east and west. The plans indicate that it is 5.22' East of Centerline.

1989 - Brian Taavola P.S. 21583 recorded this corner in Liber 3, page 101 of corner records. He found a P.K. Nail and 3 witnesses by an unknown person. He replaced it with a P.K. Nail and brass cap stamped: "Section Corner," It fell 5' East of centerline. He gave 4 witnesses:

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B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. Corner now falls at the Intersection of: U.S. Highway 45 to the NW and SE. Mountain View road to the West, a two track trail to the East and Woodspur road to the North. I recovered the P.K. Nail and stamped brass washer as called for by Brain Taavola. I recovered all of his witnesses. This corner works well with other corners to North, South, East and West. I accepted it as the section corner and added 2 reference monuments.

C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner; Corner is a P.K. Nail with a Brass Washer stamped "Section Corner." It falls 5' East of centerline U.S. Highway 45. also established 2 reference monuments, 2 1/2" x 30" aluminum pipes with 3" diameter aluminum caps. The first (R.M. 1) is to the NorthEast and stamped to indicate that the Section Corner is \$55°47'W, 64.70'. The second (R.M. 2) is to the Northwest and is stamped to indicate that the section corner is \$72°47'E 94.36'. Ties: OF MICH
