B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

All original evidence has been obliterated by extensive clearcutting and buildozing. Found the base of a bent angle iron matching Lingren's description and two of his remaining bearing trees. This position worked well with angle and distance off of centerline M-38.
