B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found no remains of original GLO corner or assessories. At the comer position I found an east-west fence and a north-south gravel road. I re-established corner position at the intersection of the fence with the centerline of the county road. This position works well with standard and closing corners to the east.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 5/8" x 24" rebar with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: T.51N., R.39W.; S.35, S.36; S.C.; 1996 P.S. 37273. Corner falls in centerline of Dutch Road and on the extension of an old fence to west, old fence to east, and a line of 3' high red painted pipes to east. Also note a reference monument (R.M.) west of the road. R.M. is stamped to indicate that S OF RICHIO the corner is 23.40' to the east.
