(B-9) 1/4 Corner common to Sections 19 & 30, T51N R40W

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

All remains of original corner and bearing trees have been removed by farming and road construction. The intersection of a very old fallen fence to the north and the centerline of an east-west gravel road is the only remaining evidence of the corner position.

This intersection works well with GLO distances east and west to section corners and I have determined it to be the best position for the 1/4 corner and have monumented it as such.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 3/4" aluminum rod with a 3" diameter stamped aluminum cap and falls in centerline of east-west. Quartz road on the extension of an old fallen fence to the north. Corner falls 6' east of the extension of a newer electric fence to the north.
