

I recovered the Original 30" Hemlock Bearing Tree, now a 36+" rotten stump with remains of Hemlock bark. I replaced the ¼ corner from this B.T. I found no remains of the 6" Maple Bearing Tree. This position falls N55°E 12.16' from a 8" Maple blazed on three sides and N73°W 43.44' from a fallen wood post with aluminum Champion tag with "1978 Approx. Cor." facing on it.
