- 1979 Robert Mick, P.S. 16936, on Ontonagon County Airport survey map on file with Plats at Ontonagon Co. Register of Deeds, notes that he set a concrete monument at this corner by single proportionate measurement and established 2 witnesses.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner; Original Corner and accessories have been destroyed by logging and road clearing.

I found a 1/2" iron encased in a 6" diameter concrete monument and Bob Mick's 2 witnesses. Monument falls on line with an east-west powerline and falls 44' west and 10' north of a Champion Intl. wood post and corner tag (set in 1995)

This concrete monument works well with other corners in area. I accepted it as the 1/4 corner and placed a 2" diameter aluminum cap on it.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 1/2" iron encased in a 6" diameter concrete monument with a 2" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: 1/4 S.3, S.10; T.51N., R.40W.; 1996; P.S. 37273. Corner falls 10' north of an east-west fence, 10' south of

centerline of a dirt road, and 108' west of a North-South creek crossing.
