

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. I found a 6" Soft Maple squared on four sides with 1975 Champion tag indicating this is the approximate Section Corner. Extensive retracement to the North, South, East, and West indicates this corner to be out of position.

tre-established the corner position by double proportionate measurement between the Section Corner one mile to the West, the Section Corner one mile to the North, the Section Corner one mile to the South, and the centerline of North-South Norwich Road (1/4 line road) to the East. Distances in all directions work well with this position. The squared Maple falls 25 feet East and 7 feet South of this position.

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C. Description of monument for comer and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
