

Ned Hawley, Timbercruiser, noted in his personal copy of the original field notes that the corner was a ½" pipe 1951 with a "Big Elm in meadow, S 55°E, 60 pcs."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found no remains of the original corner or accessories. I found the iron pipe called for by Hawley, It falls at the correct bearing and distance from the remains of an enormous elm stump in the old Levi Field. The pipe also falls at the Northerly Edge of the old Levi Field which had been farmed before 1900. The pipe has been used and accepted as the 1/2 corner position for at least 48 years. I have accepted it as the best representation of the true 1/2 corner position and have monumented it as such.
