I found no record of susequent restoration.

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

At the corner position I found a "x" x 68" iron pipe. It falls at the correct bearing and distance from the remains of the 18' hemlock, now a 25 +/-" stump, decayed to ground level. A 10" cedar with a "beaver" blaze faces the pipe. I accepted the 3/2 pipe as the 1/2 corner and replaced it with a county monument.
