- John E. Erickson P.E. 2422, in the Assessor's Plats of the NE 1/4 of Section 30 and the E 1/2 of the SE 1/4 of the NW 1/4 of Section 30 shows this corner as being a concrete monument at the Southeast corner of R.O.W.'s of Paul Bunyan Ave. and 7th Street.
- The Beach Parkway Addition to the Village of Ontonagon shows comer as being at the Southeast corner of R.O.W.s.
- Robert Mick, P.S. 16936, shows corner as being a concrete monument in surveys.
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

The original corner and accessories have been destroyed by Village street and utility construction. I found a 1/2" iron with cap no. 16936 set in the broken remains of a concrete monument. This fell at the southeast corner of R.O.W.s of Paul Bunyan Ave. and 7th Street. It worked very well with platted distances to south and east. I also found a nail and tag no. 19842 (William Riipi) in a Power pole northwest of the found iron. The iron works very well with other corners in the area.

I accepted the 1/2" iron as the 1/4 corner and have monumented it as such.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Corner is a 2" x 30" aluminum pipe with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped to read: 1/4 S.19, S.30; T.52N., R.39W.; 1996;

P.S. 37273. Corner falls southeast of road intersection at the corner of a lawn.
