Found a 1" iron pin 12" below ground, 2 remaining M.S.H.D. witnesses, and 3 Destramp witnesses.

The iron matches closely the angle and distance off of centerline M-38 as noted on Highway plans. The iron appears to have been re-establised by single proportionate measurement. Accepted comer position as monumented and replaced with a county monument.
