

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1954 - Ned Hawley, timbercruiser, noted in his personal copy of the original field notes that this corner is a 8' x 1/2" pipe established by J. Donnelly.

1978 - Robert Mick, P.S. 16936, in survey recorded in Liber 1, Page 40 of Surveys shows this corner as an iron pipe in swamp, well marked. He also shows a found pipe N 00° 39' 18" E 960.54' at the shore of Lake Superior.

B. Description of comer evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing comer:

I found a %" O.D. fron pipe at the corner with another thin wall galvanized pipe driven next to it. I found a fallen half rotten 20" +/- White Pine that matches the record bearing and distance to the original 12" White Pine bearing tree. I also found 2 large blazed White Pines facing the pipe. This pipe works well with corners called for and set in Bob Mick's survey as well as with other corners in the area.

I accepted the 1/4" O.D. pipe as the Section Corner.
