B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

M 2 Standard 1/4 corner common to Section 1, T12N, R2E - Set remonumentation monument per Spicer Engineering notes 2624.15' North of M 3 per 1967 notes. This will agree with a straight line through K 2 and L 2 per 1971 Spicer notes and observed occupational fence West in 1967. During excavation to set remon, monument found broken crockery pot and metal ring with glass and trace of wood - down 1.0' to 1.6' deep on W. side of remon, position. Monument accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

Reference Pt "A" Found PS cap 26454 on 1/2" rebar per unrecorded survey 3.06' S. of M 2. This monument was apparently established by single proportion between M 1 and Reference Pt "B" near M 3-T12N-R2E. Monument not in agreement with previous Section sub. per Spicer Notes or previous observed occupation. Monument was established using improper procedures and is not utilized as M 2-T12N-R2E in this survey.
