Position of A-12 accepted as best possible position of M-12 due to preponderance of usage and longevity of witnesses. Accepted by Saginaw County Peer Review Group on December 13, 1994.

Set post at 40 chains north of M-13, J. Wampler, 1822:

11" Ash S 11' W 121/2 links.

10" Ash S 30° E 54 links.

No available records of propagation or restoration of corner prior to 1946.

J. Martin recorded L.C.R.C., L3, P188, in 1976 noting perpetuation of corner since 1946.

Also referenced to corner 12.4' to south recorded in L2, P16. Martin noted that corner probably in error. Spicer Eng. recorded Richard J. Doerr Subdivision in 1953 using position of chiseled "x" for boundary survey. Spicer Eng. notes indicates that they used position of chiseled "x" in pavement exclusively as a corner common to Sec.36 & Sec.31, T12N, R4E.

South River Road Subdivision (L9, P7) recorded in 1955 used as the East ¼ corner, the approximate position of PK nail 12.4' south of position of the chiseled "x".

McKelvey recorded L.C.R.C. (L2, P16) witnessing PK nail.
Ledy Eng. found PK nail in 1990 (L1783, P2066) and replaced it with a RR spike at position of chiseled "x". Position of chiseled "x" accepted as A-10 by Saginaw County Peer Review Group on October 7, 1993.
