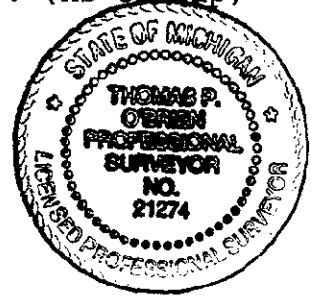

Nov. 30, 1993 Thomas P. O'Brien recovered 2 1/2" pipe w/brass cap as set by Carl Christensen.
