## A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(E7) Corner common to Sections 16-17-20-21. 1850 - Established by Algernon Merryweather Deputy Surveyor. Set post. W.Pine 20" N65W 18 links, Birch 7" S60E 14 links. 1959 - Remonumented in the original position by Billy D. Buckler RLS from W.Pine B.T. N65W 18 links, found with scribe marks plain, stump in poor condition. Set 1" ID I.pipe with 4" brass cap. 18" Red Pine N11W 87 links, 11" Jack Pine N65E 32 links, 7" Jack Pine S52W 62 links.

(E9) Corner common to Sections 20-21-28-29. 1850 - Established by Algernon Merryweather Deputy Surveyor. Original bearing trees: N.Pine 12" N80W 21 links, W.Pine 12" S35E 34 links. 1959 Remonumented in the original position by Billy D. Buckler RLS from Yellow Pine B.T. N80W 21 links and remains of White Pine B.T. S35E 34 links. Found old stake on ground and several blazes in vicinity. Set 1"ID I.pipe with 4" brass cap. 9" Jack Pine N29W 13 links, 9" Jack Pine N41E 16 links, 7" Jack Pine S13W 26 links.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- (E7) Found the 1959 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the NBT Red Pine NW and the NBT Jack Pine SW, both in good condition. The NBT Jack Pine NE is gone. The stump of the OBT W.Pine N65W is now gone. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
- (E9) Found the 1959 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from two of the three 1959 witnesses. The NBT Jack Pines NW and NE are in place and in good condition. The Jack Pine SW is now gone. The stump remains of the original BTs are in place. Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
