

Szyszkoski _ , in a field survey on do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigen P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered. found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(HI3) Quarter corner common to Sections 34 T46M-RI3W and 3 T45M-RI3W. Corner remonumented in 1970 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS, This corner replaced as set by the U.S. Dept. of Agriculture while running the boundaries of the Seney Wildlife Refuge. Found a scribed 6" Tamarack bearing, NIBM 13.9°. Found bottom of a wood post, in ground at the corner. 1° pipe with 4° aluminum cap. 5° Cedar S25M 4.6', 6' Cedar S79N 19.9'". The undersigned tried and was unable to gather field notes or maps from the U.S. Fish and Mildlife Service pertaining to the US Dept. of Agriculture (Biological Survey) survey of the Seney Refuge. It is not known where Buckler learned of the USBS work.

(5-Sec. 34) North 1/16 corner, Section 34. Corner not established in the original survey. Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(HI3) Recovered the 1970 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the remains of the 1970 witness cedars, now both cut stumps. No USBS monumentation was recovered. I determined that the monument is 1.07' North and 0.74' East of the proportionate position and I accept the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner. Left the monument in place and marked new witnesses as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.

(5-Sec. 34) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the corner midway and on a straight line between Quarter corner 1312.43' Morth and Center of Section 1312.43' South. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1 I.D. x 36' iron pipe capped with a 4° dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position_

(HI3) Found 1" Pipe with 4" MONR cap. (5) Set 1 pipe with 4 MONR cap. Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails Blazed, scribed, and set measuring mails
