

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(111) Corner common to Sections 26-27-34-35. Corner remonumented from original Tamarack BT by M.Sperhake, RLS in 1963. Perpetuated with: 1"x3" galvanized iron pipe with aluminum Kimberly-Clark Corp. cap. M. Pine 6 M71M 333 links.

(HII) Quarter corner common to Sections 27-34. Corner established in 1850 by Guy M. Carleton: "39.94 Set quarter post. Spruce 4 M56M 15 links, Spruce 3 SSE 20 links". Found no subsequent record.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

(III) Recovered the 1963 monument, as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the M.Pine witness, now 8° diameter. Left the monument in place and marked 4 new accessories as described below. Corner recovered and rewitnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.

(H11) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground.

Reestablished the corner midway and on a line of mean true bearing between Section corners 2631.20' East and Nest, being proportionate to the original record. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1" I.D. x 32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. Corner placed and witnessed by T.Stark, Newberry District Office.
