A Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(AB) Quarter corner common to Sections 19 T47MR13M and 24 T47MR14M. Corner reestablished by proportionate measurement in 1959 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS. Corner monumented with a 1° pipe with 4° brass cap and the following: 15° Red Pine S48N 122 links, 18° Red Pine M56N 182 links.

(A7) Corner common to Sections 18-19 T47NR13M and 13-24 T47NR14M. Corner remonumented in 1959 by Billy D. Buckler, RLS, at the position of a found wood stake. Corner monumented with a 1° pipe with 4° brass cap and the following: 26° M. Pine S69M 115 links, 17° R. Pine MS2E 112 links, 16° R. Pine S84E 130 links.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(AB) Recovered the 1959 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1959 witnesses. Both 1959 MBTs are dead. The 18° is still standing with scribe marks visible. The 15° is dead and down. Left the monument in place and marked 4 new accessories as described below. Corner rewitnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Newberry.

(A7) Found the 1959 monument as described, in good condition, and at record bearing and distance from the 1959 witnesses, all in good condition. Set measuring nails in the 1959 trees, and marked one new accessory as described below. Corner rewitnessed by T.Stark and D.Lampela, Mewberry.
