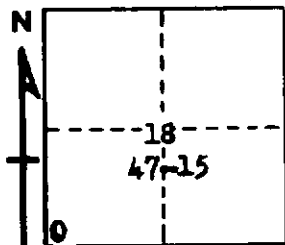

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER Sec. Cor. common to Secs. 18-19-13-24.

CORNER MONUMENT 1" pipe with 4" Aluminum Cap.

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Corner lies on a steep hill-side, facing North-East and South of a stream, about 7.0' higher than stream.

This corner replaced from one Hemlock stub, an original witness, bearing S60°W, 25 links. Both faces and scribe marks are preserved and in excellent condition. Found numerous names and dates, some before 1900.
