B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1/2" pipe at location referenced in no. 2 above. Excavated for Harrison Marker and found 1" square iron rod lying down. The square rod was tapered to a point and about 12" long. I have found similar irons that have been refered to as "drag tooths" by E.F. Joslin in County Surveyor records. Accepted this location as the careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner position. Found no conflicting evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced 1/2" pipe with standard Shiawassee County Harrison Marker monument. The monument was stamped "REMON 24622" and is witnessed OF MICHIGA by the following accessories:
