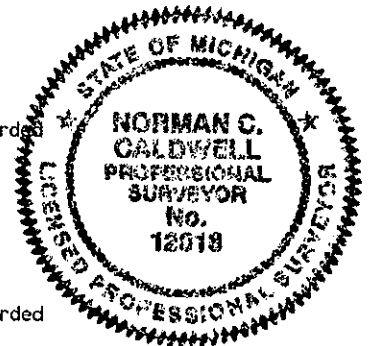

Dug a 8'x10'x3' deep hole (6" below orig. grnd), at a position at the intersec. determined by the ext. of a line from 1/4 25/36 and 36 thru W 1/16 25 & 36 with a line extended from SW Cor. 36 thru 1/4 35/36. Fnd. 2 blue stones (6"x8"x14") w/wood pst. (upright) btw. them, 12" below wood corduroy. Held this position as the cor. and placed a std. 20" Harrison marker as approved by the Shia. Co. Peer Review Group and is accepted as the best available evidence of the post. of the orig. cor.
