B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found railroad spike in Monument Box as referenced in no. 1 above. This location is 2.2 feet South of being equidistant from corners D-5 and D and is 6.05 feet West of the Michigan Meridian. I accepted this location for its position North and South but established a position on the Michigan Meridian between corners M-5 and M-6, T6N-R1W, 6.05 feet East of the railroad spike. Found no conflicting evidence.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Installed a standard Shiawassee County Harrison Marker monument at the position described above. The monument is stamped "REMON 24622 OF MICHIGA and is witnessed by the following accessories:
