Fokens, P.S. #21567, on a survey dated 18 August 1981 recorded in Liber 3 at page 579 and L.C.R.C. dated 22 February 1982 recorded in Liber 2 at page 318 found a railroad spike 6" deep in the centerline of Krouse Road and marked the following references: South 31.33' 60" Walnut, North 20.52' top center of 12" culvert, N 20 E 28.63' top center of 12" culvert, N45 W 43.24' top center of telephone riser.

Norman C. Caldwell, P.S. #12018, on a survey dated 31 August 1990 and recorded in Liber 6 at page 1, found the record railroad spike and recites the same references as Jan Fokens except that mention is made of the dimension of "West 6.58' to a 1/2" bar w/12018 cap on the Michigan Meridian".
