- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:
- M-13 Std. cor. Sec. 36, T7N-R4E, Sec. 31, T7N-R5E


Excavated 8' E-W x 20' N-S x 3' deep (15" below original ground) with a backhoe, searching for reliable evidence of the common corner of I7N-R4 & 5E on Shiawassee-Genesee County Line.

Found 6 - 5" diam. rocks around a 4" vit. clay tile w/cinders inside, over an 8" x 12" tall pointed stone. The stone is 18" below existing road surface, 6" below original ground. The top of the clay tile was flush with original ground, and encircled with the smaller stones. The stone was left in place and a 1" bolt driven alongside for ease of location for placing the Harrison monument.

This is near the "Morthern" pipe found flush w/old gravel, 8" below new lime stone surfacing.

No additional evidence could be found to support the "Southern" pipe used by REI.

I believe the stone & tile to be the monument used by Ezra Mason, Shiawassee County Surveyor, 12 & 13 Feb., 1866, and M.B. Sage, Genesee County Surveyor, 11 Oct., 1870 as verified by retracing measurements of the recorded surveys.
