Found no evidence of original monument or accessories. Found no evidence of subsequent restoration. At the Interior 1/2 corner of Section 24, (L-8) found 3/4 inch pipe as described by John Quine, in County Surveyor Record Book G, dated 6-23-87, Quine states he found a large stone with small ones around it. L. Mason's survey of 1879 calls for a large stone with small ones around it at the center of Section 24. I reasured East from the 3/4" pipe to the North and South 1/4 line fence. This distance was 1374.5 feet.
