This point has been used as corner M-6, TlON-R7E, but is out of position by 49.53' according to a proportion of the current measure to the 1888 measure along the township line from corner M-5 to M-6 and M-6 to M-7. Did not accept corner in mon. box previously used. Established and accepted corner along township line proportional to 1888 resurvey as the proper position of the original corner.
