B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found pieces of china cup, crock & red tile, 18" to 30" deep in 8" circular area from 10' x 10' excavation. Earth in 8" area soft as if post removed! No evidence of 1" pipe per 1963 witnesses. Accepted center of china, crock & tile found as best evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Removed china, crock & tile and set 36" concrete monument with standard brass cap stamped corner B-13, T11N-R11E West 606' centerline of culvert over Adams Drain. $N00^{\circ}01'30"W$ 25.00' set 1/2" x 18" rod & cap #23503 on N-S 1/4 line at South ditch bank. $N60^{\circ}21'E$ 54.34' chiseled "+" on NW face of West 2" pipe leg for electric service panel. N75°40'E 85.25' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in SE face power pole. SO1°18'W 22.95' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in E. face 8" oak. North 0.5' set carsonite witness post. OF MICHIG


