I, Kenneth D. Dunton, in a field survey on Sept. 6, 1997 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

March 19, 1834 Hervey Parke, D.S. Set quarter section post. Cedar 9" N84°E 11 1/2 links, Cedar 10" N72°W 32 links. Feb.-Apr. 1963 M.S.H.D. witness card by H. G. McManus, Survey Chief 1/2" pipe. N25°E 41.44' 24" Elm, N10°W 70.10' 12" Elm, S50°W 67.07' 14" Elm.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1" iron pipe in place. No previous accessories remain by distances shown on witness cards to corners K-13 & M-13, T12N-R9E check relative well. (see sketch on back) Accepted 1" iron pipe found as the best evidence of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Removed 1" iron pipe and placed concrete monument with standard brass cap stamped L-13, T12N-R9E.
 S75°W 68.78' set T. C. Remon. tag & spike in 4" x 4" wood post, tele. ped. support.
 S89°E 144.44' set T. C. Remon. tag & spike in S. face new p. pole.
 East 4.10' fnd. 1" pipe at apparent corner L-1, T11N-R9E.
 S03°E 68.85' set 1/2" iron rod in N. shoulder M-46.
 South 90.7' E-W centerline conc. pavement, M-46.
