Found 1/2" iron rod and pointed stone below rod. Accepted found 1/2" rod & stone as the best evidence of the original corner.

Corner A-8, T12N-R11E is common with Corner M-8, T12N-R10E.

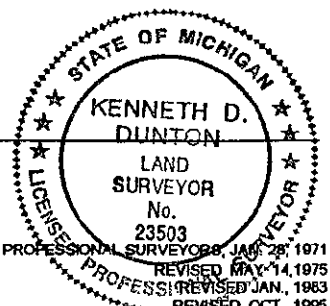
C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

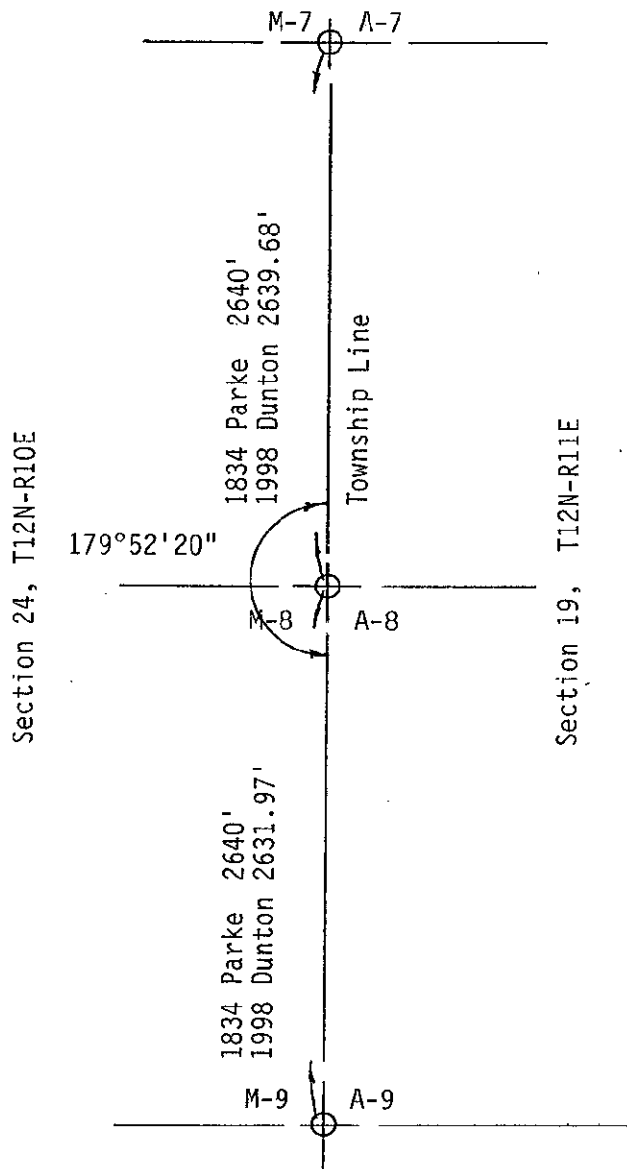
Removed rod & stone and perpetuated with standard monument stamped M-8, T12N-R10E.

 S20°W 48.84' Southwest corner of Southwest wingwall of bridge.
 S67°W 28.70' West corner of Northwest wingwall of bridge.
 S55°E 18.92' East corner of Northeast wingwall of bridge.
 S13°E 45.67' Southeast corner of Southeast wingwall of bridge.
 North 8.5' ± physical centerline of E-W gravel road.
 West 5.5' ± physical centerline of N-S gravel road.
