A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

March 18, 1834 Hervey Parke, D.S. Set post corner Sections 34 & 35. Hemlock 10" N61 1/2°W 38 links, Beech 8" N56°E 50 links. Aug. 1, 1963 M.S.H.D. witness card by Donald C. Pyle, R.L.S. #3165. Found 1" pipe buried 1'. N35°W 69.40 t.p., N45°E 72.52' p.p., N60°E 77.05' 24" twin Elm. Sept. 9, 1968 M.S.H.D. witness card, R. Fosdick, Survey Chief. 1" pipe in monument box. N45°E 97.30' p. pole, S60°W 24.50' rt. edge metal sta. 88+11.7 (pave. joint), N60°W 26.30' lt. edge metal sta. 88+11.7 (pave. joint). July 22, 1971 Survey L-1, P-139 by Kay, L.S. #14096. (mon. box) South 43.05' 2" pipe road sign post, N70°W 100.72' 2" pipe road sign post. Sept. 14, 1987 Survey L-578, P-070 & 071 by Dunton, L.S. #23503. No object or accessories mentioned.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1" pipe in monument box and three accessories that indicate the corner found is in the same position as the 1968 witness card. Accepted 1" pipe in monument box as the best evidence of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed standard brass cap over 1" pipe found in monument box. Stamped cap I-13, T12N-R11E. Encased cap in concrete in monument box. West 50.12' fnd. 1/2" rod in mon. box at apparent centerline P.I. N30°E 97.67' fnd. M.S.H.D. tag in east face p. pole. N60°W 26.20' left edge conc. pavement @ sta. 88+11.7 (pave joint). S65°W 24.50' rt. edge conc. pavement @ sta. 88+11.7 (pave. joint). North 2.0' E-W centerline conc. pavement M-46.
