Dunton, in a field survey on June 6, 1998 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and for that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found 1" axle shaft in monument box. Accepted 1" shaft as the best evidence of the original corner.

Corner M-8, T13N-R9E is common with Corner A-8, T13N-R10E.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Drove axle shaft down & placed 1" I.D. pipe & 5/8" re-rod with 2" brass cap over 1" axle shaft. Stamped brass cap M-8, T13N-R9E and encased cap, rod & pipe in concrete in mon. box. N27°W 49.03' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike over nail & disk fnd. in E. face 18" Maple. N85°W 26.85' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in S. face 18" Maple. S35°E 66.25' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike over 11192 tag fnd. in SW face 15" Pine. N85°E 75.89' fnd. old steel axle shaft at W. face 15" Apple. East 4' centerline of N-S pavement.
