G.L.O. Notes Nov. 20, 1834 by H. Parke, D.S., set 1/4 section post, Cedar 10" N60°E 35 links, Cedar 9" N64°W 15 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found nothing from several excavations along township line. Established corner position by single proportion between Corners K-13 & M-13, T13N-R11E. Accepted this proportional position as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner. Monument corner falls in line with remains of old fence line to South. Newer fence line to North is 6'± East of monument.

Corner L-13, T13N-R11E is common with corner L-1, T12N-R11E.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner;

Set standard monument stamped L-13, T13N-R11E. Set carsonite post at monument.

West 60.72' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in S. face 10" Oak (S'ly of twin 10" Oaks).

N80°W 20.75' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in NE face 10" Oak.

N15°E 21.60' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in SW cor. RR tie cor. post.

N50°E 17.61' set T.C. Remon. tag & spike in SE face 36" Oak.

South 10'± centerline trail E & W.

South 30'+ centerline of ditch to West

South 30't centerline of ditch to West.


