Found 1/2" re-rod in water valve box (similar to mon. box - slightly smaller diameter labeled "water valve") No knowledge of fate of 1" rod & mon. box per 1980 Act 74, page 42. Two accessories from 1980 check 1/2" rod in valve box. NO2°41'E 71.87' 3/4" re-rod in mon. box & S85°E 66.10' NW cor. house. Accepted 1/2" re-rod in valve box as corner M-2, T14N-R8E.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Placed 3/4" pipe over 1/2" re-rod & 5/8" re-rod with 2" brass cap in 3/4" pipe. Encased re-rod & pipe in concrete. Stamped brass cap, corner M-2, T14N-R8E. NO2°36'30"E 71.83' found 5/8" rod in mon. box at apparent cor. A-4, T14N-R9E. S59°42'W 60.30' center of 2" pipe corner post in concrete. N62°39'W 51.98' set T. C. Re-mon. tag & spike in E. face of p. pole.
