As requested by County Peer Group of Surveyors, I found 18" bolt at East Quarter Post (no stone). Goss Witnesses check to South. Then I found the Center Quarter Post, a 1" iron bar bent by phone company with trencher. Also found T. A. Smith's 3/4" pipe at start of "Simmons Beach". Ran line from pipe to East Quarter Post. Distance checked from pipe to Center Quarter Post (420'). Set iron on line at Center Quarter over iron bar. Then traversed across lake to West Quarter Post location. Distance between East Quarter Post and Center Quarter Post measured 2648.02' (Goss measured 2650.23'). The computed line came on the iron in the fence post hole and measured 2640.47'. Started to dig trench out 2648.02', but found a piece of plow point laying on its side 1.5+- West of the post hold. So I accepted the iron in the post hole and set a monument.
