M11, Post set by US Deputy Surveyor Wm Brookfield in April, 1827, witnessed to a Beech 1820°W, 25 links. In 1870, in a survey in section 30, Bangor Twp, County Surveyor AJ Pierce witness remains". Pierce measures the jog at 48 links. In 1903, Surveyor JS Haines replace section 30, Bangor Twp and notes the falling to the standard corner at N, 47 links. Railroad 8.7 east of the center of the track. In 1937, County Surveyor TA Smith found stones and brit Smith measured SW, 5.15 to the NE gage line, S, 31.68 to the Bangor corner and SE, 82.6 Surveyor AW Howard used an iron bar for the corner in a 1975 survey.
